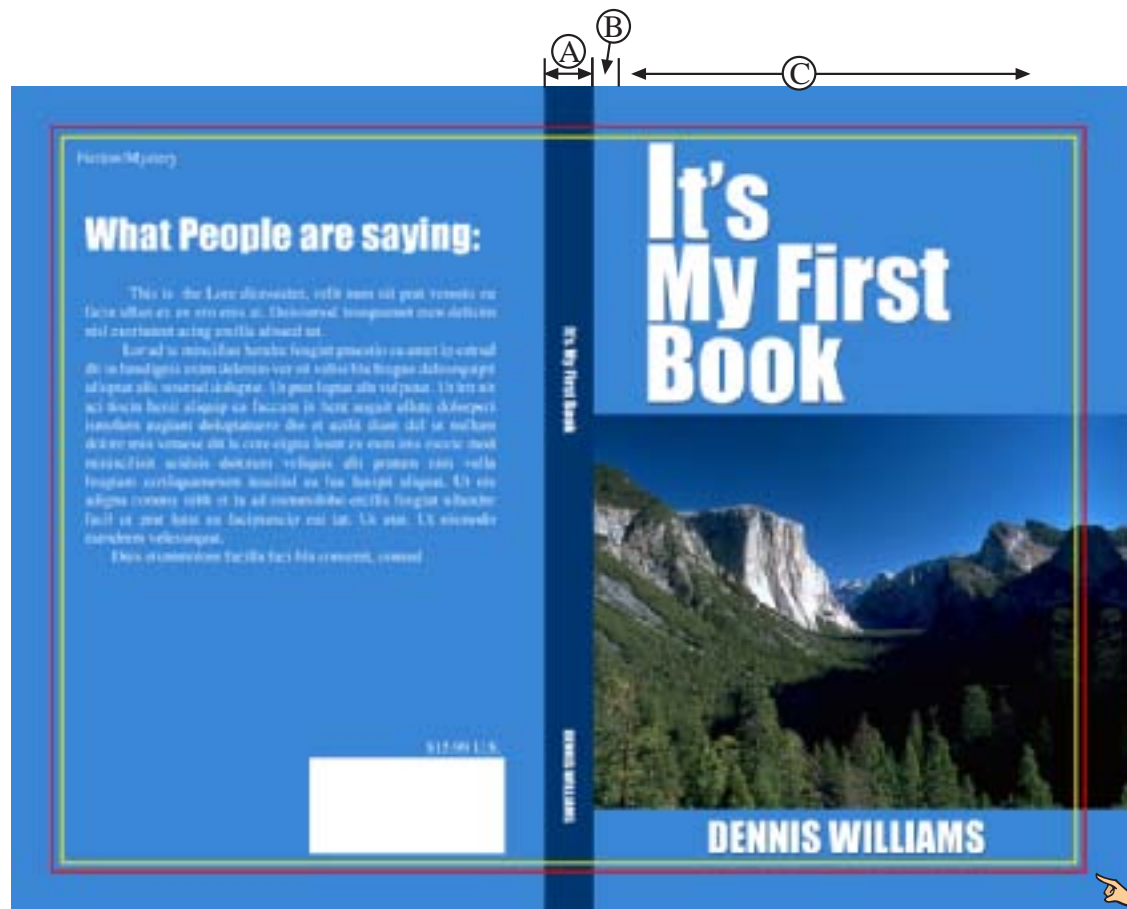




PRINTED HARDCOVER



COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING FIELDS AND THE SIZE OF YOU COVER WILL BE CALCULATED

BLEED anything that is intended to go to the edge of the paper must bleed, or extend, .5 inches on each side, or you run the risk of there being a white line on the cover.

TRIM is the size the cover will be cut to, anything outside the trim will be cut off.

SAFETY ZONE is .125 inches smaller than the trim, anything outside the safety zone may be too close to the trim and appear crowded when cut.

HINGE on a hardcover is where the front and back boards connect to the spine. You want to avoid having critical design elements in this space.
