## Text Page Layout

### Bleed

Anything that is intended to go to the edge of the paper must Bleed, or extend, .125 inches beyond the trim on each side, or you run the risk of there being a white line on the text.

### Trim

Trim is the size the page will be cut to, anything outside the trim will be cut off.

### Margins

Margins will vary from book to book, the minimum is approximately .5 inches from each side of the trim. When in doubt find a book that you like the layout of and measure the margins.
